Requirements

Successful completion of B2 English in Engineering Part 1

Examinable components

- ▶ Active participation in at least 75% of all classes and submission of assignments
- ▶ 10 min. presentation on a piece of news from the world of engineering with subsequent discussion
- ▶ Final written test (marked)

Learning Content

- ▶ Development of reading comprehension skills, applying different reading techniques
- ▶ Development of writing skills - production of different text types (definitions, test report)
- ▶ Development of oral communication skills (giving a presentation on a piece of news from the world of engineering with subsequent discussion)
- ▶ Revision and consolidation of linguistic devices expressing cause–effect or different degrees of certainty
- ▶ Revision and consolidation of grammatical structures (use of future tenses, active – passive voice, hyphenated attributive adjectives (a 20-by-17-metre shake table) etc.)

Schedule & Credit Points

- ▶ Part 2 of the two-semester “English in Engineering” programme
- ▶ 90 min/week (2 SWS)
- ▶ Offered every semester
- ▶ Credit points according to the relevant degree programme and exam regulations
