### Course description

This course is part 1 of the UNICert® III programme AND it is also an optional seminar towards the sustainability certificate NAO.

The focus of the course lies on Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and Green University.

Small teams write a project description on the topic of “Green University” and also submit it to the OvGU’s sustainability office

### Teaching materials

Teaching materials vary and are generally made available on Moodle during the course.

### Requirements

Knowledge of English at university entrance level (B2 CEFR)

### Examinable components

- ▶ Production of two texts types comprising altogether 1,200 words: Project description (teamwork) and argumentation (individual work)

#### Learning Content

- ▶ Academic Writing & Presenting
- ▶ Listening and reading skills
- ▶ Creating posters or websites
- ▶ Writing a project description for the university (green or/and sustainable university)
- ▶ Sustainability
- ▶ Referencing & avoiding plagiarism
- ▶ Formal vs informal English

#### Schedule & Credit Points

- ▶ 2\*90 min/week (4 SWS)
- ▶ Offered in the winter semester only
- ▶ Credit points according to the relevant degree programme and exam regulations
- ▶ Recognised towards the NAO certificate

#### Target Group

- ▶ Optionally required module for specific degree programs in the Humanities faculty
- ▶ Open to all students who want to obtain the Sustainability Certificate NAO
